Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during December, site condition and weather permitting:

Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will continue on Napper Road, the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, and the future park 'n' ride facility on Smith Street until the end of December.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail, available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p> <p>Energex works On Saturday 10 December, traffic signals at the intersection of Napper Road and Smith Street will be turned off between 8.00am and 4.00pm due to Energex works. The intersection will be under Police control.</p>
Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services relocation Intermittent work to relocate public utility services will continue at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive until February 2017.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail.</p>
Bailey Crescent, Southport	<p>Light rail depot – stabling yard construction Work to expand the light rail stabling facility in Southport will continue until early 2017.</p> <p>More information about the stabling yard is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>

<p>Various locations within the light rail corridor</p>	<p>Noise barrier construction and installation Noise barrier construction will continue behind Carner Court, several properties in Henry Cotton Drive, Stanton Court, Longcove Place and Longreef Crescent.</p> <p>Retaining wall construction Piling will continue for the three retaining walls located in the vicinity of the Smith Street Motorway and Smith Street.</p> <p>Rail delivery Hundreds of 25 metre lengths of steel rail will continue to be delivered to various locations along the project corridor for up to three weeks. Short-term traffic control may be required as trucks enter the site.</p>
<p>Uplands Drive</p>	<p>Terrain leveller Terrain levellers will continue rock cutting activities over the next three month period, weather permitting.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Temporary pedestrian footpath closure The 180 metre section of pedestrian footpath running alongside the Smith Street Motorway (from Uplands Drive to Carner Court) remains closed.</p> <p>More information about the footpath closure is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>
<p>Biggera & Coombabah Creek</p>	<p>Biggera Creek Bridge Early morning concrete pours will commence in early December and continue until early January 2017.</p> <p>Piling – Coombabah Creek Bridge Piling for the Coombabah Creek bridge will continue until early December. Concrete pours will commence in early December and continue until early January 2017.</p>
<p>Gold Coast University Hospital station</p>	<p>Gold Coast University Hospital station Work to construct the connection from the existing station at the Gold Coast University Hospital to Stage 2 of the light rail will continue through to early 2017.</p> <p>More information about connection to the Gold Coast University Hospital station is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>



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Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work, such as installing temporary noise blankets to shroud the work area.

Location	Night Work
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Re-lining of sewer pipes Re-lining of sewer pipes will continue along the Smith Street Motorway between 7.00pm and 7.00am until mid-December. Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September</i> for more detail.</p>
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Public utility services installation Intermittent night work to install gas pipes, conduits and pits will be undertaken on the corner of Napper Road and Smith Street, including the future park 'n' ride facility, between 6.00pm and 5.00am and will continue until the end of December.</p>
Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services relocation Intermittent night work to relocate public utility services at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive will continue between 7.00pm and 5.00am until early 2017.</p>
Uplands Drive	<p>Removal of rock Night work will continue intermittently for the next three months between 8.00pm and 6.00am, to remove the remaining section of rock from the edge of the Uplands Drive hill. This activity can take up to three nights to complete every two weeks and must be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest. Various locations within the light rail corridor	<p>Out of hours concrete deliveries Intermittent early morning concrete deliveries will occur from 5.30am for approximately four months along the project corridor. During the warmer months, concrete spraying for retaining wall construction needs to take place during the cooler morning temperatures to ensure the quality of the concrete and its finish.</p>
