Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

PROGRESSIVE TEMPORARY WEEKEND LANE CLOSURES AND NIGHT WORKS
OLSEN AVENUE, WINTERGREEN DRIVE AND PARKLANDS DRIVE



From Friday 3 March 2017 work will commence in preparation for the installation of the light rail tracks across Olsen Avenue, Southport as part of the Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 project. These works are expected to take several months to complete and will require temporary weekend lane closures and night works, weather permitting.

This work will be carried out over a number of stages:

2*	8.00pm Friday 10 – 5.00am Monday 13 March Night works: 8.00pm – 5.00am weeknights from Monday 13 – Friday 31 March	Reconstruction of the road intersection to the required level
3	8.00pm Friday 31 March – 5.00am Monday 3 April	Installation of pre-cast concrete track slabs
4	8.00pm Friday 7 – 5.00am Monday 10 April	Installation of pre-cast concrete track slabs
5	8.00pm Friday 21 – 5.00am Monday 24 April	Installation of pre-cast concrete track slabs
6	8.00pm Friday 5 – Monday 8 May	Installation of steel rail sections across the intersection – full weekend intersection closure
7	8.00pm Monday 8 May – Friday 12 May	Installation of overhead masts and power lines – overnight full intersection closures
8	Night works: 8.00pm – 5.00am weeknights from Monday 15 – Friday 26 May	Installation of lights, traffic signals and signage – night works, minimal lane closures

PLEASE NOTE: *Road works will also be occurring at the Napper Road and Smith Street intersection on the weekends of the 3-6 March (Stage 1) and 10-13 March (Stage 2). During this time the majority of traffic movements at Napper Road and Smith Street will remain open with reduced lanes and contra-flows in place. WEEKNIGHT CLOSURES


Progressive temporary night time lane and partial intersection closures on Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen Drive and Parklands Drive

Following **Stage 2 intersection reconstruction** work, intermittent **weeknight lane and partial intersection closures** will be required on Olsen Avenue, Parklands Drive and Wintergreen Drive, weather and construction conditions permitting, **from 8.00pm – 5.00am weeknights from Monday 13 – Friday 31 March**

- Vehicle access to the Gold Coast University Hospital precinct and businesses along Olsen Avenue will be maintained via Hollows Way.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Please obey all signage and detours.
- VMS will be placed in prominent locations to advise motorists of upcoming temporary night time closures of both the Wintergreen Drive and Parklands Drive intersections.

Traffic control will be in place to direct motorists, however, motorists are advised to avoid the area if possible during these works and seek an alternative route as delays are expected.

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WEEKEND CLOSURES

Stage 3 – 7 works: Major progressive temporary lane closures – Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen Drive and Parklands Drive

During **Stage 3-7 installation of pre-cast concrete slabs and pulling the steel rail across the intersection**, various large-scale temporary lane closures will be required on Olsen Avenue, Parklands Drive and Wintergreen Drive over four weekends from March to May 2017, weather and construction conditions permitting.

- Vehicle access to the Gold Coast University Hospital precinct and businesses along Olsen Avenue will be maintained via Hollows Way.
- Pedestrian access will also be maintained, though detours may be in place.

Traffic control will be in place to direct motorists, however, motorists are advised to avoid the area if possible during these works and seek an alternative route as delays are expected.

What to expect:

- Progressive temporary short-term lane closures.
- Temporary weekend intersection closures.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place to direct motorists.
- Trucks and machinery including excavators.
- Asphaltting and placement of new line-marking.
- Night work is associated with these activities.

4	From 8.00pm Friday 7 April - 5.00am Monday 10 April Installation of pre-cast concrete track slabs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Olsen Avenue reduced to a single lane – northbound contra-flow • Wintergreen Avenue reduced to two vehicle exit movements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Left-turn onto Olsen Avenue – northbound ○ Forward crossing onto Parklands Drive ○ No right-turn from Wintergreen onto Olsen Avenue – southbound.
5	From 8.00pm Friday 21 April - 5.00am Monday 24 April Installation of pre-cast concrete track slab	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Northbound traffic movements on Olsen Avenue will be restricted and contra-flows will be in place. • No right-turn from Wintergreen onto Olsen Avenue – southbound.
6	From 8.00pm Friday 5 May - 5.00am Monday 8 May Pulling rail line across intersection	The majority of movements at the intersection of Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen Drive and Parklands Drive will be closed.
7	From 8.00pm Monday 8 May – Friday 12 May Installation of overhead masts and power lines	The majority of movements at the intersection of Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen Drive and Parklands Drive will be closed – overnight closures only.

Due to these temporary closures, local bus services may be disrupted. Visit translink.com.au or call 13 12 30 for more information about changes to bus services.



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
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Detour map for access to hospitals during major intersection closures

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldLinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors are progressing with construction activities and committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.



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
