Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during March site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	Progressive temporary lane closures including weekend works Work will continue at the intersection of Napper Road and Smith Street until late-March 2017 with significant weekend temporary lane closures, weather and construction conditions permitting. Upcoming construction times are as follows:
	 8.00pm Friday 10 March until 5.00am Monday 13 March. 8.00pm Friday 17 March until 5.00am Monday 20 March – Napper
	Road will be closed at Smith Street

Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive intersection	Progressive temporary lane closures including weekend works
	Work commenced to construct the light rail across the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive on Friday 3 March and will involve significant temporary lane and intersection closures. These works are expected to take up to three months to complete, weather and construction conditions pending.

Bailey Crescent, Southport	Light rail depot – stabling yard construction Work to expand the light rail stabling facility in Southport will continue until mid-2017.

Uplands Drive	Removal of rock Rock-cutting activities will continue until mid-March 2017, weather permitting.

	Temporary pedestrian footpath closure The 180 metre section of pedestrian footpath running alongside the Smith Street Motorway (from Uplands Drive to Carner Court) remains closed.
Gold Coast University Hospital station	Gold Coast University Hospital station Work to construct the connection from the existing station at the Gold Coast University Hospital to Stage 2 of the light rail will continue through to April 2017.

Helensvale station	Pedestrian footbridge The footbridge that will connect the Helensvale station to the future light rail station will be lifted by crane into position commencing on Saturday 11 March 2017.
Parkwood park 'n' ride	Entrance into the Parkwood park 'n' ride Work will commence to construct the westbound entrance into the park 'n' ride.
	Activities will include:
	 Excavation of existing road surface. Removal of existing guardrail to make way for kerbing and guttering. Installation of road drainage. Placement of base asphalt layer.

Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	Progressive temporary lane closures The reconstruction of this intersection will take place in stages and lanes will reopen at 5.00am each morning. Intersection work will progress each weekend from 8.00pm to 5.00am until late-March 2017. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents in proximity to these works. Motorists are advised to expect delays and avoid the area if possible. More detailed information is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au
Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive intersection	Progressive temporary lane closures The reconstruction of this intersection will take place in stages. Lane closures during weeknight activities will reopen at 5.00am each morning. Intersection work will progress each weekend from 8.00pm to 5.00am until mid-May 2017.
	 Work will include: Removal of concrete islands on Olsen Avenue. Asphalt removal to install electrical service conduits and pits for the signalised intersection and street lighting. Excavation of existing kerbs and installation of road drainage. Reconstruction of the existing concrete islands. Installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting. Placement of base asphalt layer. Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents in proximity to these works. Uplands Drive	Removal of rock Night work will continue intermittently between 8.00pm and 6.00am, to remove the remaining section of rock from the edge of the Uplands Drive hill until mid-March 2017. More information about rock cutting is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au
Various locations within the light rail corridor	Out of hours concrete deliveries Intermittent early morning concrete deliveries will occur from 5.30am along the project corridor. During the warmer months, concrete deliveries need to take place during the cooler morning temperatures to ensure the quality of the concrete and its finish.









Biggera & Coombabah Creek	Biggera Creek Bridge Early morning concrete pours will continue until mid-March 2017.
	Coombabah Creek Bridge Concrete pours for the Coombabah Creek bridge will continue until mid-March 2017.
Smith Street	Entrance into the Parkwood park 'n' ride
	Work will include: Temporary lane closures on Smith Street. Traffic control and
	signage will be in place to direct motorists.
	 Excavation and trenching. Temporary lighting at the work area.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work.
