Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during April site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen and Parklands Drive intersection	<p>Progressive temporary lane and intersection closures including weekend works</p> <p>Work has commenced to construct the light rail across the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive, which will involve significant temporary lane and intersection closures.</p> <p>Upcoming construction times are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Significant lane closures at Olsen, Wintergreen and Parklands Drive from 8.00pm Friday 21 April until 5.00am Monday 24 April to install concrete track slabs across the intersection. • Full intersection closure at Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen and Parklands Drive from 8.00pm Friday 5 May until 5.00am Monday 8 May. Bailey Crescent, Southport	<p>Light rail depot – stabling yard construction</p> <p>Work to expand the light rail stabling facility in Southport will continue until mid-2017.</p> <p>More information about the stabling yard is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>
Gold Coast University Hospital station	<p>Gold Coast University Hospital station</p> <p>Work to construct the connection from the existing station at the Gold Coast University Hospital to Stage 2 of the light rail will continue through to May 2017.</p>

Various locations across the project	Installation of tracks Laying and welding of steel rail has commenced in various locations across the project and will continue until June 2017.

Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Olsen Avenue, Wintergreen and Parklands Drive intersection	Progressive temporary lane closures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lane and intersection closures during weeknights will occur from 8.00pm and re-open by 5.00am each morning. Weekend intersection work will progress from 8.00pm Fridays to 5.00am Mondays until mid-May 2017, weather permitting. Motorists are advised to expect delays and avoid the area if possible. Napper Road	Final pavement reconstruction works Work to install the final layer of asphalt, traffic light sensors and line marking at the intersection of Napper Road and Smith Street will commence in late April – early May 2017.
Smith Street Motorway	Lane closures – delivery of electrical substation An electrical substation will be delivered and craned into position west of Uplands Drive and adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway on Wednesday 26 April between 8.00pm and 2.00am. This activity needs to be undertaken when traffic volumes are at their lowest.
Various locations within the light rail corridor	Out of hours concrete deliveries Intermittent early morning concrete deliveries will occur from 5.30am along the project corridor.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work.
