Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

BUS STOP INSTALLATION – HENRY COTTON DRIVE, PARKWOOD



Construction near the Parkwood East station entrance will continue with the installation of a new bus stop and the upgrade of an existing bus stop at the front of the new station on Henry Cotton Drive. This work will start the week commencing Monday 13 November 2017 and is expected to take up to five weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting.

The existing northbound bus stop will remain open during the construction of the new bus stop at the Parkwood East station entry. The existing southbound bus stop will be temporarily relocated 10 metres north. Signage will be in place to direct commuters during these works.

Work will involve:

- Placement of temporary fencing around the work area.
- Traffic control to direct motorists during construction work and to direct pedestrians and cyclists.
- Removal of existing concrete including kerbs using excavators.
- Locating existing underground services using a vacuum truck and installing new electrical services.
- Installing formwork and pouring concrete to construct the new bus stop platform and accessibility ramps.
- Delivery and placement of new bus shelters, accessories such as signage and bin.
- Landscaping the area to complete the bus stops and removal of the disused southbound bus stop.

What to expect:

Construction work will occur between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday. Workers may arrive onsite between 6.00am and 7.00am to prepare for the day's activities.

- Increased noise levels from machinery, particularly during location of services, concrete removal and concrete installation.
- Reduced speed limit around the work area and use of a traffic controller for intermittent lane closures.

Every effort will be made to keep construction impacts to a minimum. We appreciate your patience during this important work and will continue to update you as work progresses.
