Gold Coast University Hospital (GCUH) Station Precinct

GCUH station is an existing station located near the intersection of Parklands Drive and Olsen Avenue. The station will be modified to accommodate the northern extension of the light rail line across the Olsen Avenue intersection and includes modification to the station platform.

The GCUH station will no longer represent the end of the line northern stop, with passengers able to travel from as far south as Broadbeach South all the way through to Helensvale heavy rail station.

Passengers hoping off at the GCUH station will have immediate access to the at-ground bus station located either side of Parklands Drive.

FEATURES

Key features of the GCUH station include:

- Changes to connecting shared paths which maintain line of sight.
- Separate tram platforms, single sided entry for the Gold Coast Hospital travelling towards Southport and beyond and Griffith University passengers travelling towards Helensvale.
- CCTV security cameras and emergency help points on the station platforms are monitored 24/7.
- Passenger information displays on the platform.
- go card touch points at access points.

Stage 2 stations and alignment



Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale station on the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldLinQ and CPB Contractors have committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.
