Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned to be undertaken during February, site condition and weather permitting:

Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Progressive temporary lane closures including weekend works Work will continue at the intersection of Napper Road and Smith Street until late-March 2017 with significant weekend temporary lane closures, weather and construction conditions permitting.</p> <p>Construction times are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8.00pm Friday 17 Feb until 5.00am Monday 20 February. • 8.00pm Friday 24 Feb until 5.00am Monday 27 February. • 8.00pm Friday 3 March until 5.00am 6 March. <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Motorists are advised to expect delays and avoid the area if possible. Smith Street Motorway	<p>Site access gate closure Two site access gates on the Smith Street Motorway will progressively close in February to make way for the installation of the light rail tracks.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p>
Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services relocation Intermittent work to relocate public utility services will continue at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive until late February 2017.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Refer to the <i>Construction Update – September 2016</i> for more detail.</p>

Bailey Crescent, Southport	<p>Light rail depot – stabling yard construction Work to expand the light rail stabling facility in Southport will continue until mid-2017.</p> <p>More information about the stabling yard is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>
Uplands Drive	<p>Removal of rock Rock-cutting activities will continue until late February 2017, weather permitting.</p> <p>Night work is associated with this activity – see information in night work section overleaf.</p> <p>Temporary pedestrian footpath closure The 180 metre section of pedestrian footpath running alongside the Smith Street Motorway (from Uplands Drive to Carner Court) remains closed.</p>
Gold Coast University Hospital station	<p>Gold Coast University Hospital station Work to construct the connection from the existing station at the Gold Coast University Hospital to Stage 2 of the light rail will continue through to April 2017.</p> <p>More information about connection to the Gold Coast University Hospital station is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>

Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site condition and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Napper Road and Smith Street intersection	<p>Progressive temporary lane closures The reconstruction of this intersection will take place in stages on week nights and lanes will reopen at 5.00am each morning. Intersection work will progress each weekend from 6.00pm to 5.00am until late-March 2017.</p> <p>Work will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removal of concrete islands on Napper Road. • Asphalt removal to install electrical service conduits and pits for the signalised intersection and street lighting. • Excavation of existing kerbs and installation of road drainage. • Reconstruction of the existing concrete islands on Smith Street. • Installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting. • Placement of base asphalt layer. <p>Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents in proximity to these works.</p> <p>Motorists are advised to expect delays and avoid the area if possible.</p> <p>More detailed information is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>
Olsen Avenue	<p>Public utility services relocation Intermittent night work to relocate public utility services at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive will continue between 7.00pm and 5.00am until the end of February 2017.</p>

Uplands Drive	Removal of rock Night work will continue intermittently between 8.00pm and 6.00am, to remove the remaining section of rock from the edge of the Uplands Drive hill until late February. More information about rock cutting is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au
Smith Street Motorway	Site access gate closure Two site access gates on the Smith Street Motorway will progressively close in February to make way for the installation of the light rail tracks. These works must be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist and direct motorists. Work will involve: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Relocation of safety barriers using cranes. • Temporary lane closures. • Traffic control and signage. • Temporary lighting in the work areas.
Various locations within the light rail corridor	Out of hours concrete deliveries Intermittent early morning concrete deliveries will occur from 5.30am for approximately four months along the project corridor. During the warmer months, concrete deliveries need to take place during the cooler morning temperatures to ensure the quality of the concrete and its finish.
Biggera & Coombabah Creek	Biggera Creek Bridge Early morning concrete pours commenced in early December and will continue until late February 2017. Coombabah Creek Bridge Concrete pours for the Coombabah Creek bridge will continue until late February 2017.

Every effort will be made to keep noise to a minimum for residents in proximity to the work.
