Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

NIGHT WORKS - DEMOLITION WORK WITHIN EXISTING LIGHT RAIL TRACK GOLD COAST UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL STATION, PARKLANDS DRIVE



From Monday 19 June 2017, a section of track leading to the Gold Coast University Hospital station will be demolished as part of the works to connect Stage 1 of the light rail network with Stage 2.

For the safety of workers and passengers, demolition of the existing track will commence on **Monday 19 June between 1.00am and 4.00am** each day and continue for five (5) days. This work must be undertaken when trams are not operating.

Once this section of track has been demolished, work will commence to install a new switch, which will allow trams to be guided from one track to another. This work will also be undertaken between 1.00am and 4.00am and continue for an additional five (5) days.

Work will involve:

- Jackhammering and concrete cutting from Monday 19 June to Friday 23 June between 1.00am and 4.00am each day.
- The use of an excavator to remove concrete sections.
- Installation of a new light rail switch and cabling.
- Construction of concrete formwork and pouring of concrete from Monday 26 June to Friday 30 June between 1.00am and 4.00am each day.

What to expect

- Increased noise levels and vibration from machinery, particularly during the demolition activity using
 jackhammers and concrete saws. Noise 'blankets' will be placed in and around the work area to assist with
 noise reduction.
- Dust generated from the demolition.
- Increased noise levels during the pouring of concrete.
- Lighting towers to light the work area.

Every effort will be made to keep construction impacts to a minimum. We appreciate your patience during this important work and will continue to update you as work progresses.
