Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

The Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 extension between the Gold Coast University Hospital and Helensvale stations opened for passenger services on Monday 18 December 2017. If you have any questions about ticketing, fares or to plan your journey please visit Translink.com.au or call 13 12 30 anytime.

Day Work

The following activities are planned during January, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Napper Road and Smith Street	<p>Parkwood park 'n' ride</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drainage, kerbing and asphaltting will continue at the future Parkwood park 'n' ride facility on Smith Street, opposite Napper Road.
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Temporary lane closures and speed reductions</p> <p>Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions will continue until late-February between 10.00am and 4.00pm weekdays (left lane only) to allow for finishing works on the side of the motorway and concrete barriers.</p> <p>NOTE: Night works are associated with this activity, see over for details.</p>
Various locations across the project	<p>Completion works</p> <p>Completion works including landscaping, fencing, painting and minor concrete works will continue until late-February across all areas of the light rail corridor. For your own safety, passengers and pedestrians should obey all construction and directional signage around work areas.</p> <p>Bus stop installation – Parkwood and Parkwood East stations</p> <p>The installation and upgrade of new bus stops at the front of Parkwood and Parkwood East stations is now underway on both Greenacre Drive and Henry Cotton Drive.</p> <p>This work is expected to continue until late-January, weather and construction conditions permitting.</p>

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Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Napper Road and Smith Street	<p>Ongoing works for the Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge - temporary night time road closures of Smith Street at Napper Road</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> From Sunday 28 to Tuesday 30 January 2018 temporary night time closures of Smith Street will be required nightly from approximately 7:00pm until 4:00am to complete the Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge. During these works, Napper Road eastbound and southbound will be detoured due to the temporary closure of Smith Street. Over the three nights, motorists should expect delays or seek an alternative route. Traffic control for lane closures, diversions and detours including signage will be in place to direct motorists. <p>More information will be available closer to the time including a detour map on the Stage 2 website www.gclrstage2.com.au.</p>
Smith Street and Smith Street Motorway	<p>Temporary lane closures and speed reductions</p> <p>Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions on the Smith Street Motorway will continue until late-February to allow for finishing works on the motorway and concrete barriers.</p> <p>What to expect:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intermittent temporary lane closures between 8.00pm and 6.00am (two lanes as required) Sunday to Friday until late-February. During these works, the speed limit will be lowered to 60km/h for the safety of motorists and construction workers. Traffic control vehicles and signage to support the lane closures and speed reductions will be in place. Motorists should expect delays or seek an alternative route.
Various locations across the project:	<p>Completion works</p> <p>During January and February night crews will be working across all areas of the alignment undertaking general maintenance and finishing works. Residents may experience some increased noise levels from machinery, including excavators and light vehicles.</p>
