Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2


START OF CONSTRUCTION

From July 2016, CPB Contractors will commence construction on the Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2.

Construction of the new 7.3km route between Helensvale heavy rail station and the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station will be complete in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Initial construction activities within the project corridor involve:

- Closure and detour of pedestrian and cyclist access from the Smith Street Motorway shared path.
- Installation of construction and road signage across the corridor.
- Placement of temporary fencing and erosion and sediment controls.
- Clearing of vegetation within the project boundary.
- Construction of site entry points and access gates in the project corridor.
- Stripping of topsoil and earthworks.
- Relocation of public utilities and services.
- Establishment of temporary site compounds and offices.
- Intermittent night works at various locations along the project corridor.



Work hours

Construction work will occur between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday. Workers may arrive onsite between 6.00am and 7.00am to prepare for the day's activities.

Over the life of the project, occasional out-of-hours work will be undertaken at night between 8:00pm and 6:00am when traffic volumes are at their lowest. Residents will be notified in advance prior to any out-of-hours work commencing.

What to expect

During construction, you may notice some changes around your local area such as:

- Increased levels of localised noise and dust from the use of heavy machinery and equipment.
- Increased construction vehicle movements on local roads and within the project corridor.
- Delivery of plant, materials and equipment to the project corridor.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and businesses in close proximity to the project site. We appreciate your patience during these important works and will continue to update you as work progresses.

Project information

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

The Queensland Government and GoldLinQ finalised the Stage 2 Project Documents on 28 April 2016. GoldLinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors have commenced the detailed design and approvals process and will commence construction in the second half of 2016.

GoldLinQ and CPB Contractors have committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.
